

You Don't Have to Be a Genius to Understand Fillers...

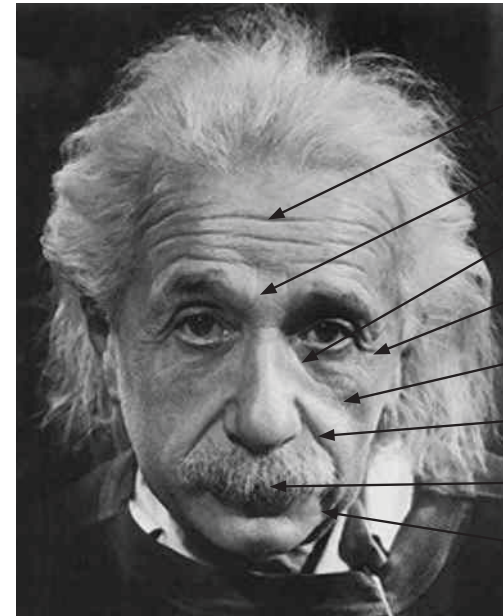
... but It Helps!

Botox and Dysport are not a fillers - they work by relaxing muscles that create unattractive wrinkles in areas where fillers are not safe or effective. Best used for: **Frown lines, worry lines, crow's feet**. They can also often create a temporary "chemical browlift" effect and end **sweaty palms or armpits**.

Thicker, heavier fillers last longer and fill more effectively, but must be placed deeper in the skin to prevent lumpiness. Best used for: **Nasolabial folds, marionette lines, sunken cheeks**.

Thinner, finer fillers don't last as long or lift deep folds as well, but can safely be used to fill lips and more superficial lines. Best used for: **Lip lines, lip augmentation, tear troughs**.

Hyaluronic acid gel fillers are the most forgiving, least likely to form lumps or bumps, and **can be dissolved** with a hyaluronidase injection if necessary.



- Worry lines (brow)
- Frown lines (glabella)
- Tear troughs
- Crow's feet/brow droop
- Sunken cheeks
- Nasolabial folds
- Lip lines/thinning lips
- Marionette folds
